Braided Lady

Offered in blue, green, or smoked reed, this uniquely designed basket has braiding on the handle to add to its beauty. It has a filled base and will offer practice in shaping from a rectangular base to an oval opening. Some weaving experience helpful. (Instructor: Linda Colton; Fee: \$45.00)



Large Laundry Basket

Don't be overwhelmed by the size of this basket. It is fairly easy to weave. Inset handles will be woven in and if desired, color can be added. It is a nice size to be used for your home or good to give as a gift. All levels. (Instructor: Janette Eitel; Fee: \$55)

Black and White Cross Stitch

Beautiful black/white basket woven on a round slotted wooden base using black 1/2" and 7 mm natural spokes. Weaving is also done with black and white reed which is completed by adding diagonal overlays. Finished with round cabinet handles. (Instructor: Pat Moore; Fee: \$65)



SATURDAY NOVEMBER 2

Wonky Tote

This basket incorporates multicolored weavers on a woven base. It is completed making a beautiful design with diagonal overlays. Completed with leather handles. Very colorful tote. (Instructor: Pat Moore; Fee: \$55)



Tray Basket

Woven on a 10"x14" wooden base with wrought iron handles, this tray would look nice centered on any table. Basic over-under weave with a decorative lattice work using bleached Hamburg cane. Several color options available for trim. All levels of weavers, including beginners. (Instructor: Jennifer Daniels; Fee: \$40)



Missouri Flag

This basket is inspired by the Missouri state flag. Incorporated in the design are the red, blue, and natural stripes along with the brown bears and the yellow from the seal. It is a great little market basket with character. Twining, start/stop weaving and shaping are techniques you will use. All levels. (Instructor: Janette Eitel; Fee: \$40)
